

KENYA 2006

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HOW IT ALL STARTED

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In 2000, 38 Venture Scouts, and Leaders departed from East Sussex to spend 3 weeks in Kenya, Africa. The purpose of the trip was to help the local Street Scouts in Kenya. These children have nothing, and very often no one. What followed was something that will never be forgotten by those there. Friendships were forged, building skills reawakened and in some cases learnt from scratch. Entirely new ways of working invented, in order to overcome the many obstacles.



Adaptability, Team work, and hard work became synonymous with what we were trying to achieve, but the rewards reaped were just as great as the time and effort given to the project. The team held a camp for 80 local Kenyan Scouts. Worked on a dormi-

tory, the shell of which was already standing, and finished off a Chicken Hutch for 250 chickens. Once the project work had been completed time was spent on Safari's and other tourist type activities before returning home.

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HOW DO I JOIN THE PROJECT TEAM

There will be a team selection day at Broadstone Warren Camp site on 2nd April 2005, starting at 10:00 and finishing at 17:00. The object of the selection day will be simply to select the members of the team that will be going with us. The team size is currently set at 18 inc Leaders. The size limit is simply because of the number of people you can fit into 1 Kenyan Mini-bus. There is an application

form attached and this should be completed and bought with you on 2nd April. **However you will need to let one of the project leaders know if you will be attending, by March 24th at the very latest.** There will also be a non returnable deposit of £100 to be paid once selected. The anticipated cost will be about £850 inc deposit.

WHAT IS HAPPENING IN 2006

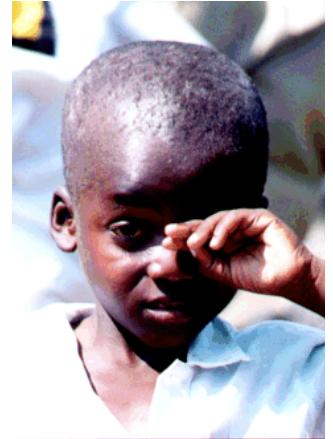

WHO CAN GO

The project is open to all active members of East Sussex Scouts, who will be over 16 on 1st August 2006.

Obviously it is preferential that you attend the team selection day, but if that is

not possible then please let the leadership team know before hand that you are interested. It may be possible for you to still join the team.

The only thing we ask is that you attend the Team build-

ing events and pay your installments on time. If you are 18 or over you must complete a CRB (criminal records bureau) form and pass the subsequent police check.

Upon Arrival at Broadstone warren look out for signs directing you where to go to check in.
